The Club has three grades of walks, 12, 9 & 6 miles all approx. You may choose which is right for you on the day - if in doubt ask one of the walk leaders. Please make sure that you have appropriate clothing, wear walking boots - not shoes or Wellingtons - bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Also bring a clean footwear for the return journey
Approximate time of return in Crewe and Nantwich will be 6 pm to 7 pm depending on the journey distance and time of year.

Pick up points are Nantwich Bus Station 0830, Wells Green Bus Stop 0835, Aldi Nantwich Road, lower end of High Street Crewe opposite the free Oak Street Car Park 0845. If the pick up is at Crewe, then the pick-up points and times are reversed starting at 0830. The start points are always indicated on the yearly walk card and the club web site.

Children On Walks - Fully paid up members shall be allowed to bring children or grandchildren between 11 and 16 years on walks subject to the agreement of the Walk Leader. This agreement must be obtained prior to joining a walk or boarding the coach.

Members shall be fully responsible for the child's safety and conduct. Parents must make sure that their children wear walking boots and appropriate clothing before they join a walk. In the event that any child is unable to complete the walk, the Member shall be responsible for the child's safety and return to the walk start point / coach.

Coach fare for children occupying a coach seat shall be £4
