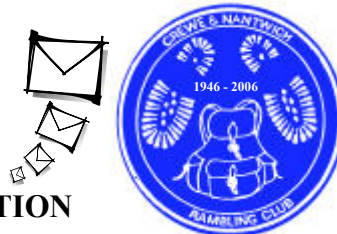


NEWS FLASH!

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING INFORMATION

Annual General Meeting - 2007 This will take place on 21st February 2007 at 7.30 pm, Lecture Room, Crewe Library. **Please note that we only have the room for 2 hours, therefore we must conduct the business of the AGM within this period or pay a considerable excess charge if we go over time!**

Consequently we will run a strictly timed agenda and are unable to have an open AOB. However, members can submit items/issues for the agenda, provided they are with the Minute Secretary - Eileen O'Toole - **at least one week** before the AGM. Please be in your place before 7.30 pm to ensure a prompt start.

Attached to this newsletter is a Committee member nomination form - if you would like to nominate current club mem-

bers for the committee, please secure their agreement to serve and return the form to the Correspondence Secretary - Kath Conroy - **at least one week** before the AGM.

This holiday is **fully booked** and a waiting list is in operation.

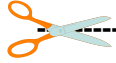
The balance for this holiday is now due. A balance payment form is attached to this newsletter., to be returned to Joan Yarwood no later than 14/02/07.
