Ramble information

Walk Leader's Expenses - With the continuing increase in coach hire charges, the Committee have been looking at ways to minimise the losses the Club is making on the coaches. At the last Committee Meeting it was decided to change the way in which Walk Leaders expenses will be calculated. From now on the expenses will be calculated on a sliding scale according to the distance required to travel to reccy the walk.

Very long over 100 miles - £20, Long 70-100 miles - £15, Medium 40 -70 miles - £10, Short up to 40 miles - £5

If the Walk Leaders car share for the reccy only one set of expenses will be paid. In the case that the Walk Leader incurs an additional expense (such as Car Park charges) the Treasurer should be informed for the payment of these.

In addition to this payment the Walk Leader will not have to pay the Coach Fare of £10 and will travel for free.
