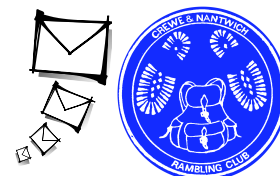


DEATHS OF SHEILA NICHOLLS & LAURIE McKENNA

Conduct of coach walks - issues arising from the walk at Chipping as well as other walks were discussed at length in committee. Members are reminded that if 2 walk groups are already on the coach ready to leave, then the last group back should de-boot quickly and be ready to leave without delay. Our coach company has also confirmed driver's hours **is not and never has been an issue.**

Map Library - Peter Norbury & Kath Conroy have now revamped this, sorting previous walk info into walk areas and removing duplicates. All is contained in one plastic storage box.

Survey on future Club Holidays - this was circulated on a recent coach walk.
