#### AGM 2022/23 (14th February) Highlights

Chairmans Report thanking all contributions to the club throughout 2022.

Escalating coach losses have been mitigated through increases in annual membership fees. Indeed, the club's membership currently exceeds 113 in number although the process of collecting renewal fees remains ongoing.

Sunday coach walks now use Global Travel; Burland Coaches ceased trading last year.

### **Committee Meeting News (9th March)**

The Treasurers report identified that 88 out of 119 have currently renewed their subscriptions. *Members are asked to complete their renewals by 31st March.*

The club remains very keen to attract new walk leaders. If you're interested, please speak to John Moreton or any committee member.

In response to criticism of Global Travel, the club have reviewed pricing of forthcoming walks and have agreed that Global Travel are still financially competitive; therefore, they will remain as the club's coach company of choice for the immediate future.

The club will again be represented at Nantwich Societies Spectacular 2023 on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July between 9am (8:30am setup) and 2pm. *Please engage with the committee if you would like to offer support.* 

Provisionally, the Conway Meal Walk will take place in October. John Moreton is securing services of 'The Gladstone' pub in Penmaenmawr on the basis that members will fund a small non-refundable deposit and settle their accounts individually.
