Committee Meeting News 18th Jan

The current membership stands at 120; this excludes 8 guests who are yet to join the club.

Whilst coach losses continue to mount, the attendance of 50 ramblers on the Marple Bridge yielded a long overdue profit of £ 74. A review of club actions arising when coach capacity is exceeded highlighted the need for volunteer car drivers at Nantwich and Crewe prepared to transport ramblers. Bryan Clydesdale offered to provide additional transport at Nantwich; John Moreton is seeking out a Crewe pickup volunteer car driver.

Agreement was reached to continue outbound segregation of "A" walker's rucksacks in the forward luggage compartment. Other "A" walker expediting measures involve their walk leader providing advanced notification of pending destination arrival. The need to corral "A" walkers in forward coach seating is no longer necessary.

The Boxing Day walk at Ash was attended by 12 members; all deemed the event very successful.

Agreement on the forthcoming AGM Agenda was achieved. The agenda has been emailed to members and published on the website. This will be revised in February to include additional member sponsored items.

Since our last publication we have witnessed the sad passing away of two former club members: Margaret Harvey and Brian Wrench.

Twelve members have expressed an interest in attending a walking weekend at the Elan Valley Lodge. A list of available dates will shortly be distributed to interested members.
